BBAG

FERGUSON SPENDING TOPPED BY TEOFILO COLT

A beautifully sunny day and, probably more importantly, a reduced catalogue and selling on one rather than on two days, helped the BBAG Yearling Sale post much improved figures across the board. A strong international presence also endorsed the view that 'quality over quantity' draws buyers.

Having been conspicuously absent from this sale last year, Darley more than made up for it this time round. Even though John Ferguson only paid a flying visit and had left by the time the sale took off, he had found a number of horses which tickled his fancy and left instructions with Franziska Schaertlin Coffey, Darley's German face.

Darley's first and most important buy of the day entered the ring as **Lot 153**, an attractive, well-made son of **Teofilo** and the German Champion Two-Year-Old Filly **Boccassini**. Consigned by Gestut Westerberg and one of the auction's 'talking horses', the dark bay colt set the ring alight thanks to a spirited bidding duel, which in the end boiled down to a battle of wills between German trainer Andreas Lowe and Schaertlin Coffey. Having had the last word at €220,000 – with a sales docket signed in the name of John Ferguson Bloodstock – she commented: "He's a lovely individual, out of a very good racemare by a sire we very much believe in. He was our pick of the day – and we're delighted to support the German industry."

Just an hour from the end of the sale, Schaertlin Coffey outdid Peter Schiergen and Luke Lillingston to secure **Lot**

235, a chesnut son of the sadly deceased sire Singspiel for a final bid of €180,000. The well-muscled colt, a three-parts brother to the German Champion Two-Year-Old and Three-Year-Old miler Lateral, was consigned by Gestut Fahrhof, whose manager Stefan Ullrich commented: "He is a really nice horse – and we did expect him to be our top lot of the day. We've had a good sale and overall our expectations were a little exceeded; the national marketplace continues to be difficult enough, but there was lots of international interest and activity. In general, I would say there is a better international acceptance of the German yearlings, which encourages breeders to continually support this sale."

Much earlier, there was already proof of just how willing Sheikh Mohammed's operation was to make a contribution. John Ferguson was also down as the buyer of Lot 166, the only Cape Cross colt in the sale (consigned by Gestut Ebbesloh) for €85,000, and Lot 167, a Dubawi colt from Gestut Fahrhof, who was hammered down for €95,000. Seemingly on a roll, Schaertlin Coffey also bid on the next yearling, Lot 168, a daughter of Shamardal, consigned by Gestut Karlshof, but walked away as the underbidder on this one to give way to another international buyer in the shape of Team Valor's Barry Irwin, who signed the ticket at €155,000. Delighted with his buy, he commented: "She is a terrific looking filly with lots of power behind and she'll be a lovely middle distance prospect for the future. She will go into training with Peter Schiergen initially, but all my purchases will eventually be shipped back to the US."

Asked about the sale, Irwin said, "I was at this sale only once before - and I bid on two horses only [one of which

was subsequent Gr.3 winner **Daveron**). This time I found eight that fitted my requirements well enough to bid on and I bought three of them, so that gives you an indication of the improved standard right away."

A familiar face in the leading buyer ranks in Germany, Dirk Eisele, from BBA Germany, was back in action for a number of high profile acquisitions. Unsurprisingly, Lot 178 was the most expensive of them, as he is an athletic colt by Sholokhov from the Etzean consignment and had had tongues wagging way before the sale, being a fullbrother to German Horse of the Year and multiple Gr.1 winner Night Magic. Whereas his big sister had changed hands for the relatively modest price of €43,000 four years ago, a lot more was needed to secure this colt. After prolonged bidding the hammer came down at €200,000 and a beaming Eisele, who had struck for the same connections of Night Magic in owner Hans-Gerd Wernicke and trainer Wolfgang Figge, was full of praise for his latest purchase. "He's a beautiful horse, a fantastic mover with lots of presence. An athlete through and through - and if he's anything like his half-sister his price will look a bargain," he said.

Another buyer making waves was young funds manager Eckhard Sauren, who signed for three high profile lots at this sale. Lot 48, an Oasis Dream filly from Gestut Fahrhof, a full-sister to Gr.1 winner Querari, was bought for €100,000, while he also bought Lot 49, a High Chaparral colt from Gestut Wittekindshof for €190,000.



His other purchase, **Lot 179**, was the sale's only offering by champion sire **Galileo** from the latter consignor. Of his purchases, he said: "I think the overall standard this year is very good and nice horses are making plenty of money. The market is stronger than I had hoped, but I am nonetheless very happy with all of my purchases. They have all been produced and presented by very good breeders. The Oasis Dream filly and the Galileo colt will both go into training with Mario Hofer, while the High Chaparral will go to Waldemar Hickst."

On Lot 49, the most expensive of his purchases, the enthusiastic investor elaborated: "He's by a very good sire and out of the most reliable broodmare I can think of. From eleven foals **Saldenschwinge** has produced ten winners – eight of them black type. The only one of her progeny that hasn't won I owned and he, too, was a very talented horse, but unfortunately got injured before he hit the track. I am very hopeful for this colt."

A standout on looks, **Lot 70**, a daughter of **Montjeu** and the Gr.2 Prix Pomone winner **Avanti Polonia**, had attracted plenty of interest in the days leading up to the sale. Hushed into silence by auctioneer John O'Kelly, bidding on the quality filly quickly entered six figures and it was Borje Olssen who fought off Ukrainian Viktor Timoshenko in the end to come away the winner at €190,000. As it transpired after the sale – he had acted on behalf of the consignors Gestut Ebbesloh – who bought out their partner in the filly. Suzanne Roberts, the stud

manager said: "She's special – and she has been like that from day one. It's not very often that horses like this come along – but when you have one, you know it – and all you can do is to get them to the sale in one piece and good condition. But it's all there."

BBAG managing director Carola Ortlieb said: "This was a blinder of a sale for us! Our grand total increased by nearly a million Euros for 50 fewer horses plus the average went up 24%, and these figures do not include the buybacks! A total of ten yearlings realised \in 100,000 or more, while the general turnover reached \in 5,470,500, a truly great increase. The sale percentage reached 70%, while the median ended at \in 28,330 and the average price rose by some \in 7,000 from last year to \in 33,356 in 2011, which accounts for a healthy middle market with all these figures excluding the buy-backs."

FRANCE

SEEKER AND INTENTION STAR AT LONGCHAMP

Adventure Seeker gained her first win at Listed level with a narrow victory in the Prix de Liancourt, one of three Listed races on yesterday's Longchamp card.

The three-year-old daughter of veteran sire **Bering** just got the better of **Aspasia De Mileto** (**Hurricane Run**) in a close finish involving the first five home.

She won on her debut in March before finishing in the frame in the Listed Prix Finlande at Longchamp the following month, and the Gr.3 Prix Cleopatre in May and the Gr.2 Prix de Malleret at Saint-Cloud in June.

Owned and bred by Wildensteins, she is out of a halfsister to the Gr.2 Prix Greffulhe winner Along All (Mill Reef), while their second dam is the Champion racemare All Along (Targowice).

Mixed Intention collected her second Listed win, when victorious in the Prix de la Cochere on the same card. She won the Listed Prix de la Californie back in February and was disqualified when first past the post in the Listed Prix Ronde de Nuit the following month.

The three-year-old daughter of Elusive City ran on well yesterday to win by half a length from Rosa Bonheur (Mr Greeley). Bred by Oghill House Stud and a Goffs, Tattersalls and Arqana graduate, she is the first foal out of the unraced Chiosina, a Danehill Dancer half-sister to the Listed Premio Torricola winner and Classic-placed Aria Di Festa (Orpen), from the family of the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches winner Danseuse Du Soir (Thatching). Her yearling full-sister was bought for €50,000 at Arqana last week and will join her elder sister in the care of Fabrice Vermeulen.

The last of the Listed races, the Prix de Boulogne, was won by the five-year-old gelding **Saga Dream**. The son of **Sagacity** asserted close home to beat **Don Bosco** (**Barathea**) by a head for his first win at Stakes level. He began his racing career in claimers and has risen through the ranks, first to handicap class and then to Group level, when finishing third in the Gr.3 Grand Prix de Vichy in July last time out.

Bred by Anthony and Bruno Audouin, Frederic Landais and Anthony Gohier Oger, he is the second foal of his winning dam **Manixa** (**Manninamix**).

ITALY

STRATEGIC GAME LANDS SECOND LISTED RACE

Strategic Game (Choisir) landed his second Listed win yesterday at Florence in the Premio Toscana. The big colt, owned by Scuderia Effevi, set a decent pace and stretched clear entering the straight to score by two lengths from Lo Zoccolo Duro (Acclamation), who finished well, while II Banchiere (Bertolini) stayed on for third.

Strategic Game, a \le 21,000 purchase at the SGA Selected Yearling Sale, now has a record of four wins and a place from five starts and earnings of \le 76,160.

Bred by Signore Alberto Panetta, he is out of the Listed Premio Novella-second **Minodora** (**Marju**), who is a half-sister to the Listed Premio Buontalenta winner **Woopi Gold** (**Last Tycoon**).

BRITAIN

AHEAD AND HOOF IT HEAD COMPETITIVE FIELD IN SPRINT CUP

A field of 16 are engaged for the Gr.1 Sprint Cup at Haydock today and it looks an open and competitive renewal. **Dream Ahead (Diktat)** and the supplemented **Hoof It (Monsieur Bond)** are currently vying for favouritism.

If Dream Ahead had not turned in a lacklustre effort when seventh in the Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville, he would be a red-hot favourite. He looked the outstanding sprinter around when winning the Gr.1 Darley July Cup at Newmarket and no explanation has come to light about his run at Deauville. If he turns up in the same form he was in at Newmarket, he will be hard to beat.

Hoof It produced an excellent weight-carrying performance to win the Stewards Cup at Goodwood and things did not really go to plan when he was sixth in the Gr.1 Coolmore Nunthorpe Stakes at York, being caught in the middle of the track. The step back up to six furlongs should be in his favour and he looks to have excellent claims for the indefatigable Mick Easterby.

Bated Breath (Dansili) also did not have things go his way in the Nunthorpe, being drawn on the wrong side of the track and the ground was possibly softer than ideal for

RACING REVIEW

BBAG GRADUATES BOOST POSITIVE MOOD AT THE SALES

These lines are written before the finish of the BBAG yearling sales at Baden-Baden, but the prevailing mood before the sale seemed to be one of cautious optimism, following the positive results from Deauville and Doncaster.

The sale was also given a boost by the results of the race meeting here, which ends tomorrow, with numerous BBAG graduates winning the feature races. This follows a good year for the BBAG, highlighted by the Gr.1 success of **Danedream**, who cost just €9,000 at their Breeze-Up Sale here last year, and the Gr.1 Kentucky Derby success of **Animal Kingdom**, whose dam **Dalicia** was sold here. Her close relation **Daveron**, their dams were sisters, was also sold here and is also a multiple winner of Stakes races in the USA for the same owner, Barry Irwin's Team Valor.

The meeting began with an easy win for **Zazou** (**Shamardal**) in the Gr.3 Preis der Sparkassen Finanzgruppe. He had been a smart three-year-old last year, finishing second in the Gr.1 Deutsches Derby, but rather lost his form; he was coming off a break here and running for the first time for new trainer Waldemar Hickst. Zazou was bred by Gestüt Fährhof and sold as a yearling to present owner Werner Heinz for €38,000 here.

The following day's Gr.2 Goldene Peitsche was also won by a BBAG graduate, although there is little German blood in his pedigree. He is the US-bred **Silverside** (**Pleasantly Perfect**), who was consigned by Huggan Bloodstock and sold to the MAB Agency, acting on behalf of Spanish owners, for €28,000 at the 2008 Breeze-Up sale.

Obviously the winners of the BBAG sales races were also won by graduates. The race for two-year-old fillies was won by **Survey** (**Big Shuffle** out of a **Lando** mare), who scored easily by three lengths. She was bought for only €9,000 by trainer Mario Hofer, who has shrewdly retained a major share in her. She is from the penultimate crop of Big Shuffle, who is well on the way to a posthumous Sires' Championship here. The sales race for three-year-olds went to Gestüt Bona's **Salut** (**Lomitas** out of a **Tiger Hill** mare), who was bought back by her breeder for €20,000.

Another very cheap purchase was **Rosello** (**Lacroix** out of a **Zinaad** mare), who cost only €3,000 at last year's Breeze-Up; he is tremendously improved and made all the running to win a Listed stayers' race and is now regarded as a possible Gr.2 German St Leger candidate.

Possibly the most impressive winner of the meeting so far was the **Königstiger** colt **Why Not**, who ran away with a three-year-old maiden over nine furlongs on his belated debut. He was not cheap, costing his owner Rupert Plersch €150,000 at the 2009 yearling sale, but from the way he won

by six lengths, he is worth every penny. Bred by Gestüt Fährhof, he is out of a **Surumu** mare, who won the Gr.2 German St Leger and is also the dam of the Group performer **Win for Sure**. He is closely related to Sir Henry Cecil's good filly **Wild Coco**. For his sire, this was the fourth good winner in the last two weeks. Two more maiden winners at the meeting worth a mention are the two-year-old **Kolonel**, from the first crop of **Manduro**, who scored easily on his debut, and is bred by Rolf Brunner, who was also Manduro's breeder; and the three-year-old filly **Leopardin**, by current German Champion Sire **Areion**, out of **Lolli Pop** (**Cagliostro**). Areions rarely get this distance, but there is plenty of stamina on the dam's side; her half-brother **Liquido**, won both the German and Italian St Legers and another half-brother is a smart hurdler in Britain.

GROSSER PREIS VON BADEN

The meeting's top race is the Gr.1 Grosser Preis von Baden over a mile and a half, which will be run tomorrow. One British-trained runner and one from France face four German hopes. The German three-year-olds Danedream, a filly by Lomitas, and **Waldpark**, a **Dubawi** colt, are the likely favourites. Danedream, as mentioned earlier, a BBAG bargain buy, was a most impressive winner of the Gr.1 Grosser Preis von Berlin last time and earlier won the Gr.2 Oaks d'Italia by more than six lengths, previously finishing third in the Gr.2 Derby Italiano. She just keeps on improving and there is as yet no way of knowing how good she is. **Silvaner**, also by Lomitas, is her stable companion but the stable's second string. Bred by Gestüt Fährhof, he won the Gr.3 Preis des Winterfavoriten, but his form is not up to Gr.1 standard.

Waldpark, from a distinguished Ravensberg family, has only run five times and is the least exposed runner. He was an easy winner of his four races, including the Gr.1 Deutsches Derby and can be excused his latest performance in the Gr.2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano, where he lost a shoe early on and finished very sore.

Night Magic (Sholokov) is a standing dish here, having won all her three starts at Baden-Baden, including the Gr.1 Grosser Preis von Baden last year. Although she was five lengths behind Danedream at Hoppegarten last time, she can never be underestimated here. She is almost certainly running her last race and it is expected that she will shortly be sold to an international breeder.

Both the foreign runners are by **Montjeu**. The colt **Joshua Tree** was trained by Aidan O'Brien when he won the Gr.1 Canadian International last year, but was then sold to Qatari owners and has recently joined Marco Botti's Newmarket stable. The filly **Maria Royal** is now Japanese-owned, but trained in France by Alain de Royer-Dupré. She won the Gr.2 Prix de Royallieu last year, but again her overall form is not convincing. The race has been won in the past by many top British and French runners, but this time the prospects of a home victory look good.

him. He was only beaten half a length by Dream Ahead in the July Cup, albeit comfortably held.

Kingsgate Native (Mujadil) was two places ahead of Hoof It in the Nunthorpe and shaped as if five furlongs was on the short side for him nowadays. However, he is on a long-losing run and is not straightforward.

James Fanshawe relies on Society Rock (Rock Of Gibraltar) after ante-post favourite Deacon Blues (Compton Place) was ruled out earlier in the week because of a poor scope. Society Rock gained Gr.1 glory in the Golden Jubilee Stakes at Royal Ascot and there was no disgrace in his second, beaten four lengths, to Moonlight Cloud (Invincible Spirit) in the Prix Maurice de Gheest.

Saeed bin Suroor will be hoping the ground dries up from its current description of good for his charge **Delegator** (Dansili). He did not have things go his way when fifth to Dream Ahead in the July Cup and ran as if something was amiss in the Gr.2 Lennox Stakes at Glorious Goodwood. He was very impressive when winning the Gr.2 Duke of York Stakes on his reappearance and is a very high-class horse on his day, as evidenced by his second in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas and Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes.

Elzaam (**Redoute's Choice**) was disappointing when eighth to Dream Ahead in the July Cup, when it was felt that he was not suited by the run of the race, and had finished two lengths behind Society Rock in the Golden Jubilee.

Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj), winner of the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere at Longchamp last year, showed more of his sparkle when fifth in the Prix Maurice de Gheest and ran as if the drop back from seven furlongs to six could be in his favour. The trip, however, is unlikely to be ideal for Sole Power (Xaar), winner of the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes last year, and that will possibly also be case with Masamah (Exceed And Excel).

There is just one filly in the race, **Bewitched** (Dansili), and she looks no forlorn hope. She disappointed in the Golden Jubilee but the ground possibly was not ideal and on her previous start she beat **Zoffany** (Dansili), who has done the form plenty of favours since, in the Gr.3 Ballycorus Stakes at Leopardstown. She has already won over course and distance and there could be an improved showing from the four-year-old filly today.
